
Annual Parish Meeting 10th March 2021 Income, Expenditure and Grants





Notes: Community Infrastructure Levy is a levy paid by developers to Wiltshire Council when they build in the County. The Parish Council receives 25% of this levy for any building in its area. The majority of this for Calne Without has come from the developments at Cherhill View off Stockley Lane and Studley Gardens at Studley crossroads. The Council is allowed to spend the funding on infrastructure and community facilities, the Parish Council's policy on how it spends CIL is available on the website.

Precept is the Parish Council's part of the Council Tax collected by Wiltshire Council. The Parish Council can reclaim VAT on some items.




