

1 Introduction

The Footpaths Working Group was formed in June 2020.

The Group has the following objectives, timescales and reporting set out in the Terms of Reference:

Objectives

- To carry out an audit of the existing paths, cycleways and bridle paths, identifying the routes and structures along it and any barriers to its use.
- To recruit volunteers to help carry out the audit and assist in the maintenance and improvement of the network.
- To identify places of historical or landscape importance to the Parish.
- To promote the use of paths by residents and visitors and to identify projects to encourage the use of the asset.

Timescales

The Working Group will aim to recruit volunteers and carry out the audit of routes during the summer 2020 provided that Government advice prevailing at the time allows this to happen.

Reporting

The Working Group will prepare an initial action plan to present to the Parish Council detailing its strategy and Councillor responsibilities for the recruitment of Volunteers and the methodology for the audit. The Working Group will use the resources provided by Wiltshire Council to guide their work.

The Group's work has been restricted by the ongoing Covid-19 restrictions and rules and perhaps the scale of the task was not appreciated in the first instance.

2 Footpath Survey

The detailed results of the survey so far are attached at Appendix 1.

31 paths have been surveyed so far and while most are in good condition there are stiles that need attention and signposting that needs improving or replacing.

The Parish Council will need to work with Wiltshire Council Rights of Way team to establish how any issues found will be dealt with and improved, for example signage work is best done by Rights of Way officers with experience. If the Parish Council is able to recruit

members of the public who would be willing to become countryside volunteers and carry out works to keep paths in good condition, they will need to undergo training by the rights of way team first.

The Council had received a request for assistance with work to upgrade stiles to kissing gates from a landowner back in June. The request was for 5 kissing gates but only one of the locations was actually within the Parish the others being in Calne Town. The Council responded that it wished to carry out the footpath survey and set priorities for improvements before responding to the request, the Council may wish to revisit this. The original request is shown at Appendix 2.

3 Conclusion

As the group has been so restricted in its work over the last 9 months it may be advisable for the Council to review the timescale and reporting plan for the Group and update the Terms of Reference accordingly.

Recommendations:

- 1. That the Council review the progress of the Working Group and set a programme for the future work.**
- 2. That the Council revisit the request for assistance with improving a stile on footpath CALW35 to a kissing gate, if the works have not already been carried out.**

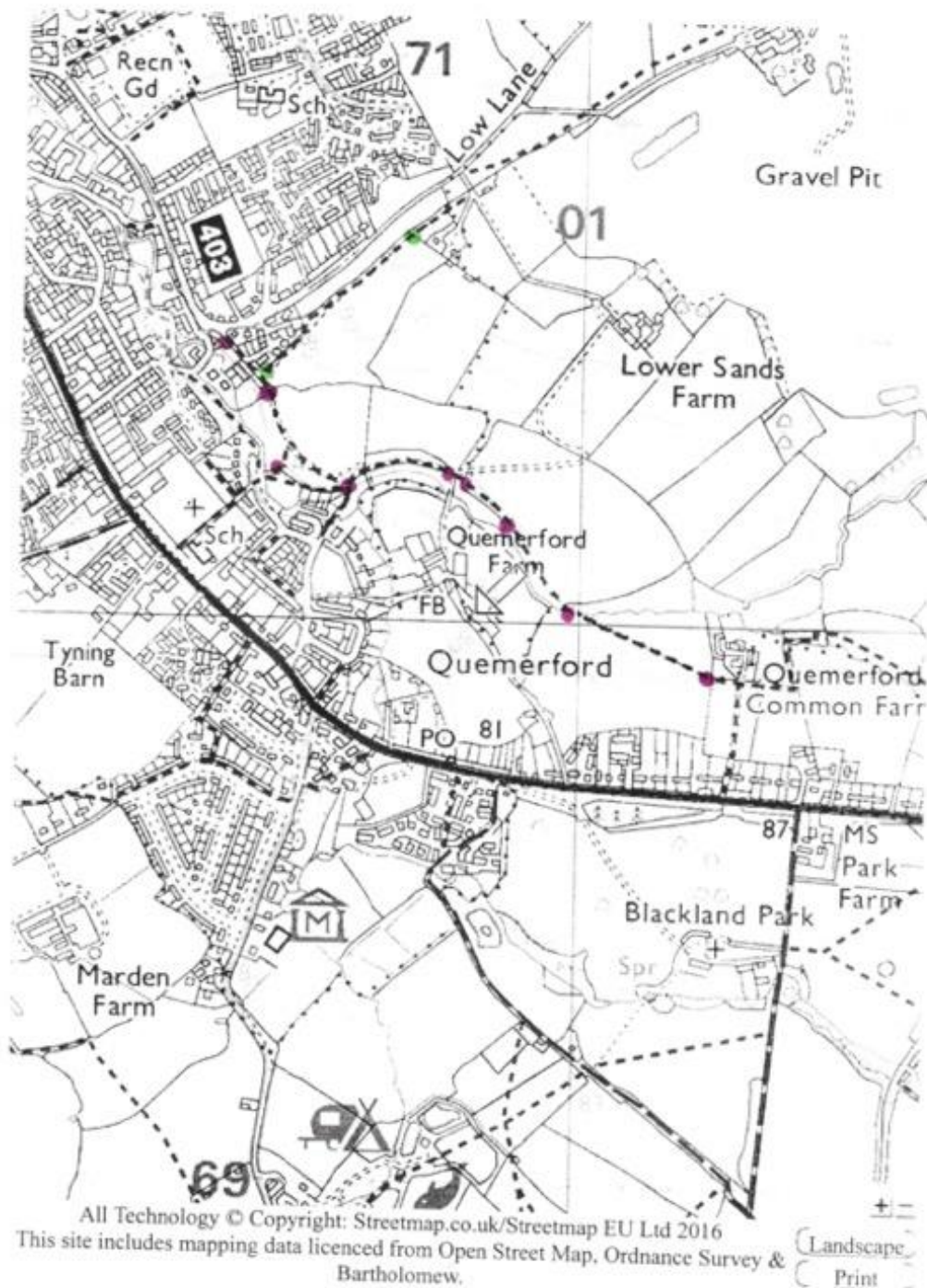
