REQUEST FOR FUNDING SUPPORT BY CALNE-WITHOUT PARISH COUNCIL FOR THE DERRY HILL & STUDLEY HEARTBEAT COMMUNITY FACILITY OF DEFIBRILLATORS, 2023.

Background: The community volunteer group of Derry Hill & Studley HEARTBEAT

(DH&SH) has, since 2014, bought, installed and maintained life-saving defibrillators for the Derry Hill & Studley Community. There are currently 5 units in operation located to minimise the access distance for residents should they be required. The coverage would be improved further by the installation of a sixth unit located to the east end of Old Road/A4. An agreement has been made with the Derry Hill United Football club to host th sixth defib unit on the sports pavilion wall enabling full public access. This replaces the defunct unusable unit that DHUFC had in the past.

Money for these installations and the maintenance of them has been achieved by **DH&SH** by fundraising events and seeking donations from local businesses, developers, residents and the Parish Council (£750.00 last year).

Proposal: Funding is requested for 2023 for the sum of £2,200.00 to achieve the

sixth unit that will complete the coverage of the Derry Hill & Studley defib

zone.

Reason: During the COVID pandemic, events to raise funds were severely limited and

2022 was a large drain on the funds of DH&SH.

The last three years have not allowed the current funds to have gained sufficiently to purchase the 6^{th} unit for the east end of the Derry Hill and

Studley area (Old Road/A4), hence the request of £2,200.00.

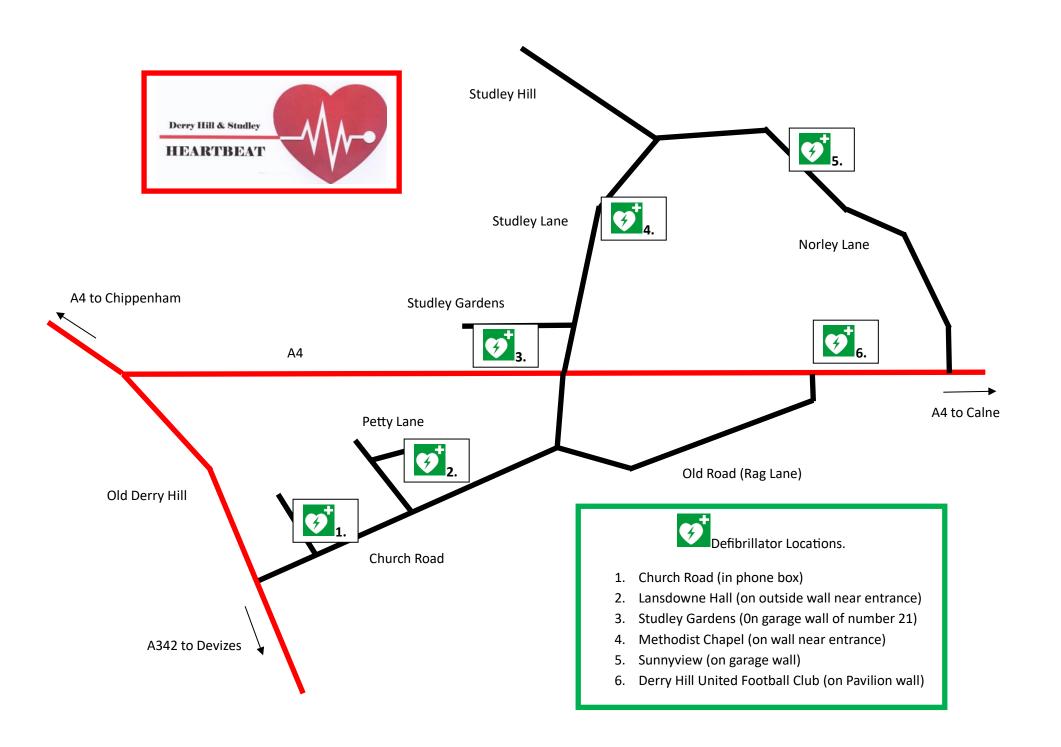
Summary: With the need to maintain the existing units, and provide for the eventual
