

Energy saving & Local Environment Event

Saturday 16th September from 10am to 2.30pm at Landsdowne Village Hall

Objective

1. To provide local people with practical information and inspiration on how they can reduce their household energy bills and make their homes more comfortable, providing accessible, relevant and ideally locally-based information that people can act on. The emphasis is on reducing costs rather than carbon emissions, to make it interesting and relevant to as many people as possible.
2. To provide local people with practical ways they can protect, enhance and support their local environment through presentations by local organisations and stalls with practical applications of what they can do and / or opportunities to volunteer.

Format

Stalls from contributors with an emphasis on engagement and take away information (including video displays). Wherever possible, to include stalls from local, independent and objective organisations that have no commercial incentives.

Talks by contributors – short, focused on practical information and actions residents can take.

Take-aways – focus on information and links for participants to follow-up later, alongside any ‘promo’ gifts that installers or commercial organisations might offer. Ideally small samples of simple home retrofit interventions like draught proofing.

Family friendly: craft tables for families to make things like hot water bottle covers and draught excluders. Clare’s Circus. Families to bring pledge written on an ‘Apple’ template to pin on our homemade Apple Tree and receive a free sustainable gift.
