9.1 Update from CCNP

This is more than the £2,000 that has been the norm for the past few years due to the potential additional complexity of undertaking the review post Community Governance Review changes. It is intended that this money is used to fund the review of the whole Calne Without part of the plan area. The mechanism for allocating this money across all successor councils will be decided at a future date, but it could follow the same model as currently used i.e. Calne Town Council contracts with third parties and is reimbursed for the Calne Without element. It is expected that Calne Town Council will also allocate funding for this purpose.
