10.2 A4 Studley Crossroads Speed Limit Reduction – approval of increase to Parish Contribution

To authorise payment of the Parish Council's contribution towards the completed speed limit reduction scheme on the A4 at Studley Crossroads, which requires an increase in authorisation from £3,750 to £3,821.31, representing 30% of the final cost.

10.3 A4 Studley Crossroads Speed Survey
